

Maestro WorkLife Coaching - Small Group Idea Guide

(This idea guide can be used to generate ideas on how you can use Maestro WorkLife Coaching Features within small groups to help meet the needs all people who work)

The Maestro WorkLife Coaching System has many small group tools embedded within it. You can use the tools and features of Maestro in creative ways to grow small groups in the area of WorkLife. Here are some ideas:

- Maestro WorkLife Coaching Sessions delivered via email on Tuesday and Thursday of each week are specifically designed for personal growth and use in small group environments. Each Coaching Session has discussion questions and a work application prayer. Because they are delivered to each group member enrolled in Maestro, coordination is easy. Additionally, the past five years (hundreds) of coaching sessions are available online for further exploration.
- The WorkLife Issues Assessment is a dynamic online instrument that pinpoints a person's top 3 work issues that keep them from practicing an effective life at work. Small groups can use this to help identify issues.
- The WorkLife Issues Assessment Results can be used in a small group as an accountability tool to share among members. For example, each member reports how they are doing on their Top 3 Work Issues disrupting their Rhythm at work.
- WorkLife Issues Assessment Why not have small groups assess which work issues are most pressing and have that group go through the Maestro Truth Modules (studies) for those issues together over a certain number of weeks.
- Maestro WorkLife Truth Modules are designed for personal use or within groups. There are 30 Truth Modules (bible studies), one for each of the Top 30 Work Issues a person faces. Each Module is undergirded with one of the six Biblical Principles guiding Maestro. They can be mixed randomly, done in sequence or done in 5 separate six-part series around the 6

WorkLife Principles. Your choice. The studies are embedded in the web portion of Maestro as PDFs and are accessible 24/7 and can be shared either by online links or as an attached PDF file.

- Study the 6 WorkLife Principles in Small Group as a foundation for understanding work. You can find a PDF of these 6 principle studies on the Small Groups area where you found this guide. The 6 WorkLife Principles are Clarity, Calling, Balance, Skills, Influence, and Relationships.
- Show Maestro Animated Overview to Small Group Increase use and growth of WorkLife in your church by showing Maestro video to groups or sending the overview to them electronically. You can lead them to the WorkLife Issues Assessment.
- The WorkLife Small Group Resources section on the Maestro web bookstore is a compilation of published discipleship resources in print and on video. The topics including the purpose of work, calling, balance, wisdom at work, evangelism.
